

Annual Fund Giving

The Foundations of Hawai'i Pacific Health reinforce the mission of each of our nonprofit hospitals by raising awareness and cultivating philanthropic support from the community.

One major source of this support comes from Annual Fund Giving.

The Annual Fund allows patients and friends to make yearly donations in support of Straub Clinic & Hospital, Kapi'olani Medical Center for Women & Children, Pali Momi Medical Center and Wilcox Health.

Contributions to the Annual Fund provide the ongoing funding needed for Hawai'i Pacific Health to provide health care services and specialty care in the community; actively engage in a broad range of medical research, education and training programs; and sponsor public health initiatives and services aimed at improving health quality outcomes.

Types of Annual Fund Gifts



ANNUAL FUND

Unrestricted Annual Fund gifts support the area of greatest need at each facility. These gifts ensure that there is always funding available for critical medical services, new technology, research and education.

Designated Annual Fund gifts subsidize specific program areas. Below is a sampling of the programs that received designated monies during Fiscal Year 2010:

STRAUB FOUNDATION

Bone & Joint Center

Funds support Hawai'i's first multi-disciplinary center that provides comprehensive orthopedic, sports medicine and rheumatology services.

Cardiology/Heart Center

Funding helps Straub provide a full range of adult cardiac services.

Family Health Center/Clinics

Gifts support medical care for the entire family at one of the many Straub clinics throughout the state.

Oncology/Hematology

Gifts support the care and treatment of cancer and blood disorders. Also helps provide education and emotional support to patients and their families.

Summer Student Research Program

Funding supports the Summer Student Research Program, which gives undergraduate college students interested in a career in medicine the opportunity to participate in an 8-week clinical research project while learning about the practice of medicine.

Straub Burn Unit

The Straub Burn Center is the only primary and tertiary burn treatment center for Hawai'i and the Pacific Region. Funds provide care for adult and pediatric burn victims.

KAPI'OLANI HEALTH FOUNDATION

Kapi'olani Beads of Courage

Beads of Courage are given to women and children undergoing cancer treatment at Kapi'olani Medical Center for Women & Children.

Kapi'olani Breast Center

Funds are dedicated to the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of breast cancer.

Kapi'olani Pediatric Transport Team

The Neonatal Pediatric Transport Team brings children from all over the Pacific Region to Kapi'olani for care.

Kapi'olani Women's Ambulatory Cancer Center

Funds are used to improve the delivery of treatment & comfort of patients.

Pali Momi Cardiology

Funding supports cardiac programs at Pali Momi, including the new interventional catheterization lab.

Pali Momi Retina Fund

Funds support ongoing research efforts at Pali Momi Medical Center for the prevention and treatment of retinal diseases.

Pali Momi Women's Center

Funds are used to provide programs and services for women at Pali Momi.

Sex Abuse Treatment Center

Funds support Kapi'olani's statewide program providing Hawai'i's sexual assault victims with 24/7 crisis intervention; medical-legal examinations; therapy, case management and legal systems advocacy; as well as community prevention and education.

WILCOX HEALTH FOUNDATION

Cardiology Services

Funds raised by the Hawai'i Pacific Health Employee Giving Campaign support cardiac care.

Pediatric Services

Funds are used to purchase specialized equipment for pediatric treatment.

Women's Health Center

Funds support the renovation and expansion of the facilities and services of Wilcox Memorial Hospital's Women's Health Center.

Nursing Scholarships

Funds support Kāua'i Community College Nursing school students who have ties to Hawai'i and intend to practice here upon graduation.

Other Ways to Support the Foundations

CAPITAL AND SPECIAL PROJECT SUPPORT

Capital and Special Project Support includes gifts made above and beyond Annual Fund contributions, often in the form of multi-year pledges. This restricted support allows each of our hospitals to make improvements and complete projects that could not otherwise be funded.

Report from the Foundations of Hawai'i Pacific Health Executive Director

Shingo Kaya was a quiet man who never complained and always took care of others. As the middle son he cared for his family and, following the passing of his wife, raised six children on his own. He worked hard and gave back, serving on the board of his church, donating blood and after retiring, helping low-income families with their taxes. Kaya’s family admits it was difficult for him to depend on others for care, but the staff at Straub earned his trust by always taking into account the whole person.

Because of the care he received, when their father passed away, the three Kaya sisters all had the same idea – to honor the doctors and nurses at Straub with a donation to Straub Foundation. “I think the family will never be able to thank Straub enough,” says Susan. But, their father raised them to acknowledge good things by giving back and making a gift to Straub just seemed like the right thing to do.

NEW EQUIPMENT

Ultrasound Machines

Two new ultrasound machines in the echocardiography lab provide the latest in image acquisition, including 4D imaging, which aids in the accurate diagnosis of patients.

RENOVATIONS & EXPANSIONS

Inpatient Cancer Unit

Staff at Straub Clinic & Hospital know that renovations to the sixth floor will have a positive impact on patient care and comfort, because they will include many of the same changes the fourth and fifth floors have already received. Renovations include redesigned rooms and an upgraded call system, which scans staff members' badges so they can be easily located when needed.

Plans for the sixth floor also include unique additions such as a new Family Counsel Room. This room will provide the privacy necessary when staff meets separately with family members to discuss plans and patient progress.

Another special feature of the sixth floor renovations will be four negative pressure rooms. These rooms are used for patients that require isolation, preventing the spread of airborne illnesses and reducing risk to other patients.

Mililani Clinic

The expansion of the Mililani Clinic, which re-opened in March 2010, has already made a difference to this growing community. Patients are enjoying the updates to the 20-year old clinic, which included refurbishments to create a brighter environment, and expansions to help grow the clinic's capabilities.

Your support of Kapi'olani Health Foundation enables specialized health care which takes into account the unique needs of Hawai'i's women and children

Each year, Kapi'olani Medical Center's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit plays a vital role in the lives of nearly 1,000 premature or low-birth weight babies. The specialized care provided by Kapi'olani's dedicated staff is made possible in part through generous donor gifts made to the Kapi'olani Health Foundation. While the medical team is always comforted watching their tiny patients go home with their families, they find even greater joy when those babies return as healthy adults for a special thank you visit.

Eighteen years ago, Kaisha Hanson was one of those tiny patients. When Kim Hanson started pre-term labor, she was rushed from her home in Kaua'i to Kapi'olani Medical Center for Women & Children as a high-risk maternity patient. Shortly after, tiny Kaisha came into the world nearly 10 weeks early and weighing less than 5 lbs.

"She was born with critical lung and blood problems," said Kim. "Staff warned us that she might not survive and if she did, she could have physical and developmental problems. But the care we received was above and beyond in every way. Nearly 2 decades later I still remember how much those doctors and nurses did to comfort us and help Kaisha get better."

Just two weeks after Kim and Kaisha were sent home, Hurricane Iniki hit Kaua'i. Because of Kaisha's still fragile condition, the medical staff at Kapi'olani worked with her pediatrician to quickly arrange for transport to O'ahu so both mom and baby would be under continual care until the natural disaster was over.

Because of Kapi'olani's expert care, Kaisha went on to live a healthy, normal life. The family eventually moved to Utah, but when Kaisha graduated from high school with honors, her mom and dad decided to bring her back to visit the place that saved her life.

“Kapi’olani Medical Center is the reason Kaisha is here to live her life without physical and mental restrictions,” said Kim. “Although we live on the mainland now, we wanted the staff to see what a difference they’ve made in our lives and how grateful we are for the miracles they perform everyday.”

During the visit to Kapi’olani, Kaisha was able thank one of the nurses who was assigned to her care 18 years ago with a hug that brought everyone to tears.

“I had always heard the stories about this place from my mom,” said Kaisha. “But it’s incredible for me to come back now and see all these tiny babies on life support just like I was.”

The experience has been such an influence on Kaisha’s life that she plans to become a child-life counselor so she can help families like hers in the future.

Even 3,000 miles away in Utah, the Hansons are spreading the message of Kapi’olani among friends and co-workers. Kim wants everyone to know about the hospital that saved her daughter’s life.

“We as a family hope with all our hearts that the community truly understands the impact Kapi’olani’s staff has on the world every day.”

Partnership with University of Hawai’i

Saving Minutes, Saving Lives

Community support of Kapi'olani Health Foundation enables Pali Momi to offer life saving services close to home for Leeward residents

When Cheryl Kozai, Director of Clinical Services at Pali Momi Medical Center, worked to open an interventional catheterization laboratory at Pali Momi, she never would have thought that her father, Bob Koide, would be the 26th patient treated at the new facility.

Bob Koide woke up one morning to play golf, and felt what he describes as a finger poking his chest. Later, on the course, when one finger turned into three, he called his wife, Judy Koide, who suggested he go to Pali Momi.

When Mr. Koide arrived, Cheryl received a call from the Emergency Department. Her father was there and he was having a heart attack.

Cheryl recalls the period of waiting, while staff performed the interventional procedure that would save her father's life, as being surreal. But she was not worried at all. "Trusting that my father was receiving excellent care was the best affirmation for me that what we've been saying to people is true."

Prior to the lab becoming equipped to perform interventional procedures, patients could only be diagnosed at Pali Momi. Now, with the opening of the lab and the addition of Medical Director Dr. John Kao, patients can also receive the first-rate, life-saving care they need.

In the past year, the lab has seen nearly 475 patients. And although those statistics prove the need, opening a new facility required more than that. Pali Momi also had to show that it had the resources to support the lab. This is why your support is important. Contributions help us maintain the facility and make it successful.

Because of generous community support, the Pali Momi family is continuing to expand. Right now, the focus is on growing the services we provide - through new procedures and preventative education.

SPECIALIZED SERVICES

Full-time Chaplain Services

The addition of Chaplaincy Services at Pali Momi gives us the ability to care for our patients' and their families' emotional and spiritual needs, whatever their religious preference.

Build the Gastrointestinal Program

Patients from all over the state come to Pali Momi for endoscopic ultrasounds as this technologically advanced procedure allows for the early detection of tumors, dramatically increasing survival rate of patients. This past year, a bariatric/gastrointestinal liaison was hired to further develop the existing program, and a gastrointestinal referral program was initiated to help formalize and streamline the process for patients.

NEW EQUIPMENT

Upgrade to Medication Bedside Barcode Scanning

Scanning of medication doses prior to administration ensures that we achieve the 5 rights - right patient, right medication, right dose, right route and right time. Accomplishing this upgrade required the purchase of new equipment, repackaging of medications and training for pharmacy, nursing, respiratory therapy and other staff who will carry out the new procedure.

AWARDS & RECOGNITION

Breast Imaging Excellence

The Pali Momi Women's Center in Aiea has received accreditation from the American College of Radiology as a Breast Imaging Center of Excellence. Because Pali Momi's Breast Imaging Center took the extra step of achieving accreditation for a full suite of screening and diagnostics services, it is ranked in the top 5% of centers nationally and is one of only two on O'ahu to receive the certification (Kapi'olani's Women's Center is the other).

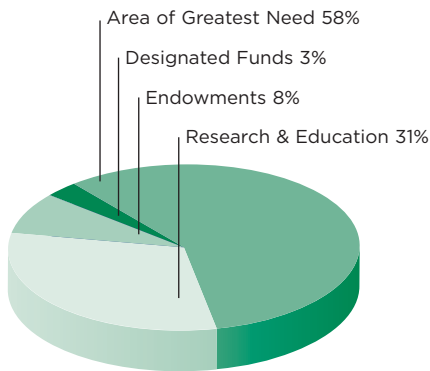

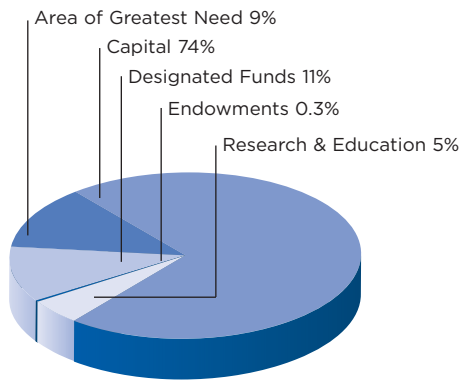

The following charts represent the uses of contributed revenue during Fiscal Year 2010.

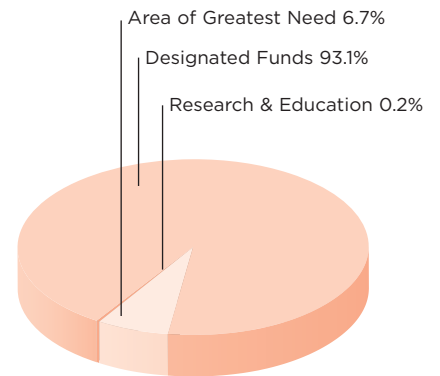
